Fitting 99 to 2005 MIATA SEATS with Patton Machine Miata Seat Mounts

Patton Machine Miata Seat Mounts are designed for Miata seats from 1990 to 1998 also known as the NA model. NA rails are adjusted fore and aft with a lever under the front edge of the seat. Some later seats can also be fitted but require using the rails from the earlier NA seats.



The seat rails in this photo are from a 99 to 2005 Miata and are known as the NB model. **The NB rails pictured do not fit Patton Machine Mounts.** These rails adjust fore and aft with the lever shown in the photo.

The NB seat rail closest to the middle or tunnel (upper in the photo) has a rear portion that cannot be straightened and will not fit the Patton Machine mounts. The solution to fitting 99 to

2005 seats is to replace the seat rails with the earlier NA rails. All four rails are not needed, only the two closest to the tunnel or center of the car. The incompatible inner rails are the ones with the adjustment lever in the photo.

Both the NA and NB seat bodies fit in a TR6 as they are the same size however the NB rails do not fit our mounts and must be fitted with NA rails to work.

The later NC seats starting with 2006 are too wide and may also interfere with the folding top.
